SKIN DEEP


Dr. Stuart H. Kaplan, a Beverly Hills dermatologist and founder of KaplanMD Skincare products, reveals his recipe for a perfect polish:

HYDRATE. Use body lotion right after showering for optimal moisture penetration. Look for products that contain avocado oil, oatmeal, shea butter and squalane.

SOAK. Taking oatmeal baths softens and soothes skin, especially if it is dry and flaky.

EXFOLIATE. Use a body scrub in the shower at least 1-2 times/week. Choose products with fine grains—such as date seed powder or jojoba esters—to minimize harsh scraping.

AVOID. Long hot showers strip skin of necessary oil. This causes dry, flaky skin. kaplanmd.com.

Around California—over lunch at Mozza or jogging through the Presidio—the names of obscure but truly effective skincare product lines are traded with the fervor and secrecy of Silicon Valley stock tips. One name being whispered loudly of late is Chanel Jenae of **The Arcona Studio**, a maverick Santa Monica-based beauty company with a passionate (and growing) set of fans. ¶ Stepping into the realm of Arcona, which has thrown out much

of the industry's reigning skincare doctrine in favor of a finely-tuned scientific approach, can have a bewildering effect. As clients quickly discover during one of the highly individualized facials—rich, creamy moisturizers are verboten. Instead, the regimen calls for light applications of airy hydration serums with names such as Magic White Ice. Arcona's products are geared to restore the skin's natural state of balance through what amounts to a detox for the face. Regular use of enzyme-based products, all of which are cold-processed in small batches to preserve their effectiveness, actively prompts skin cells to regenerate, creating a youthful glow. ¶ Not to be mixed with other products, the Arcona approach is all or nothing, and it requires something of a leap of faith. 5 EVERYDAY REGIMENS TO REMEMBER



Dr. Timothy Jochen

According to Palm Springs-based dermatologist and cosmetic surgeon Dr. Timothy Jochen, anti-aging is about regularity and maintenance:

USE SUNSCREEN. Think of UV exposure like leaving a T-shirt out in the sun—it gradually destroys the fibers.

MAINTAIN WEIGHT. Gaining and losing too much weight can result in bagging and stretching of the skin—particularly in the jawl, eye and cheek areas.

RETINOIC ACID. Everyone should be using a form of Retin-A mixed with their moisturizer.

DAILY USE OF AN ALPHA HYDROXY ACID. Glycolic and lactic acids for skin's turnover is important.

REPEAT LIKE "RENOVATIONS." For example, Botox updates can preserve that area of the face.
